FIRE CLEAN is a product specifically designed to remove soot deposits, carbon residues, and grease from the glass and ceramic surfaces of stoves and fireplaces, as well as grills, barbecues, ovens, grates, soapstone, walls, and bricks. Its strong and immediate action also removes smog from walls and coatings, as well as the typical "streaks" that form on radiators.

Instructions for use

Spray **FIRE CLEAN** undiluted onto the surface to be cleaned and allow it to act for about 3 seconds. Remove residues and rinse the treated area with cold water. If the deposits are more stubborn, allow the product to act for a few minutes.

Application

Apply **FIRE CLEAN** undiluted, using a sponge or brush.

Consumption

The consumption of **FIRE CLEAN** varies depending on the method of use and the required application.

Warnings

Do not use on hot glass.

Use the product following good working practices and avoid dispersion into the environment.

Wear appropriate protective equipment (gloves, safety goggles, etc.).

Store the product indoors in closed original packaging, away from weather, frost, and heat sources.

Do not release into the environment: follow local disposal regulations.

Always perform a preliminary test before use.
