Gomma Lacca ABTN is a waxy-resinous natural secretion produced mainly by the female insect Tachardia lacca Kerr, now known as Kerria lacca, belonging to the Coccidae family. It is used for wood finishing as well as for the sizing of felts, fabrics, wallpapers, and similar materials.

Instructions for use

Dissolve approximately 50-100g of **Gomma Lacca ABTN** in about 1 liter of ethyl alcohol (94° or 99°). Let the mixture rest for 24 hours, then shake well before use.

Application

Once the Gomma Lacca ABTN-ethyl alcohol solution is ready, apply it using a cotton pad or a perfectly clean cloth.

Consumption

The consumption of Gomma Lacca ABTN varies depending on the application method and the specific use required.

Warnings

Use the product according to good working practices, avoiding its dispersion into the environment.

Wear suitable protective equipment (gloves, safety glasses, etc.).

Store in well-ventilated areas, away from heat sources.

Do not release into the environment; follow local regulations for disposal.

Always perform a preliminary test before definitive application.
